INSURED

Students who are travelling on journeys authorised by the Science and Technology Facilities Council provided such insured person is normally resident in Britain.

COVER

- Personal Belongings – GBP 10,000
- Money – GBP 5,000
- Disruption – GBP 250,000
- Personal Accident – GBP 25,000
- Personal Liability – GBP 5,000,000

STFC's business travel insurance policy provides for unlimited emergency cover for injury or illness within the LTA country of residence.

The medical insurance arrangements are not intended to provide comprehensive cover for all health needs; students must have full dental and optical checks and complete any prescribed treatment before departure.

Pre-existing conditions are not covered under the policy.

Students in Europe must obtain a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for healthcare to cover the duration of their LTA. The EHIC card allows UK residents visiting European Economic Area countries and Switzerland the same access to state-provided medical treatment as residents in cases of accident or illness. Many countries expect the patient to pay towards their treatment; even with an EHIC visitors might be expected to do the same but they may be able to seek a refund of this contribution on return to the UK where this cannot be done in the other country. Medical expenses incurred outside the LTA country of residence will not be refunded unless incurred whilst on official duty. Accordingly, personal travel insurance is strongly recommended to cover medical expenses that could arise during a holiday outside the country of residence.
